

- Are based on a user centric technology development approach
- Demonstrate a clear business development route to market
- Provide real added value for clearly defined end user groups

TWO TYPES OF INSTRUMENTS

- Collaborative Projects (up to 3 years, substantial testing, strong commercialisation strategy and short time to market)
- Small Collaborative Projects (between 6 to 9 months, max. public contribution of 300.000 and leaner application & reporting process
