## 1. Call AAL-2019

This report presents some statistics on the proposals submitted in the framework of the sixth call of the  $2^{nd}$  phase of the AAL Programmes entitled "Sustainable Smart solutions for Ageing Well".

The call deadline was on May 24<sup>th, 2019,</sup> with an indicative total funding of 27,775,400 € that was committed by 21 national funding authorities from 16 AAL Partner States and the European Commission.

For the second time, the call allowed for more flexibility regarding the scope, size and duration of the submitted projects by including a new type of instrument, namely the "small collaborative project". Consequently, two type of projects will be funded under this call: "collaborative projects" and "small collaborative projects".

In total, 83 proposals were submitted: 58 collaborative projects and 25 small collaborative projects, one of which did not match the central evaluation criteria and was not admitted to the evaluation phase. Below is an overview of the numbers (in terms of participants, geographical origin and funding) on the 82 proposals, on the collaborative projects as well as on the small collaborative projects.



### Chart 2: Number of coordinators in submitted proposals






Chart 3: Total cost and total requested funding for submitted proposals










Chart 7: Number of coordinators in submitted proposals






Chart 8: Total cost and total requested funding for submitted proposals




Chart 9: Ratio of total requested funding over total project cost




Chart 11: Number of partners in submitted proposals






Chart 12: Number of coordinators in submitted proposals





Chart 13: Total cost and total requested funding for submitted proposals












Chart 15: Organisation types in submitted proposals

Chart 16: No. of organisations in ranked proposals per country





Chart 17: No. of coordinators in ranked proposals per country










Chart 19: Ratio of total requested funding over total project cost in ranked proposals



Chart 20: Organisation types in ranked proposals





Chart 21: Percentage of enterprises against all participating organisations per country

Chart 22: No. of organisations in ranked Collaborative Projects proposals per country






Chart 23: No. of coordinators in ranked Collaborative Projects proposals per country




Chart 24: Budget figures in ranked Collaborative Projects proposals per country






Chart 25: Ratio of total requested funding over total project cost in ranked Collaborative Projects proposals



Chart 26: Organisation types in ranked Collaborative Projects proposals





Chart 27: Percentage of enterprises against all participating organisations in ranked Collaborative Proposals

Chart 28: No. of organisations in ranked Small Collaborative Projects proposals per country






Chart 29: No. of coordinators in ranked Small Collaborative Projects proposals per country




Chart 30: Budget figures in ranked Small Collaborative Projects proposals per country






Chart 31: Ratio of total requested funding over total project cost in ranked Small Collaborative Projects proposals



Chart 32: Organisation types in ranked Small Collaborative Projects proposals




Chart 33: Percentage of enterprises against all participating organisations in Small Collaborative Projects
